Is the work no bigger than 100cm x 100cm in width and height and no deeper than 30cm (or 39.5 inches x 39.5 inches X 12 inches)?

Do you believe the work is appropriate for a culturally/age related diverse audience?\*

Do you live in Wales?

**If it's a 'yes' to all the above, here are the key dates and details for how to submit your work:**

Please bring your work to g39, Oxford Street, CF24 3DT, on Thursday 30 May between 2pm-6pm or Saturday 1 June between 1pm-6pm

There is parking outside, and if you need help when you arrive, please call the number below and we'll give you a hand.

If you are posting work we will need it to arrive no later than

Wednesday 5 June, and please include a return address so we can send it back to you at the end of the exhibition.

*If you are unable to deliver your work for mobility or other reasons of access, please contact us on the email or phone number below and we will try and arrange another means of getting your artwork to the gallery.*

**By submitting your work you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:**

**1. Display/Framing**

We will accept work in any 2D medium, framed/stretched artwork needs to reach us ready to hang with mirror plates attached at the back, halfway down the vertical sides of the work. Unframed work will be pinned, or attached using adhesive from behind, you are welcome to include a note with your preference for how work on paper is attached to the wall. Oversize works will not be accepted.

## 2. Delivery of work

The artwork needs to reach us by the times allocated above when you will be given a receipt for your work. Any submission after these times will not be hung unless we have spoken to you in advance and made alternative arrangements. Work will be condition checked on unpacking, and you will be given a receipt.

## 3. Standard and content of work

All artwork should be presented to the highest quality possible and safe to hang/display. Unframed work is fine, we will use glue dots or pins to attach, you will need to provide fixings if you want magnets etc to be used.

\*All works will need to be appropriate for a culturally/age related diverse audience, and we will not accept images which may cause offence. Work will be shown at the discretion of Pam/g39, and whilst our aim is to include all submissions, we also have to consider whether content is likely to cause offence. If for any reason, you are unsure about the suitability of your work, please contact us on the email below and we can discuss your concerns. The final say remains with Pam & g39.

## 4. Hanging of work

Hanging and exhibiting of artwork will be done by MiR and the technical team at g39, all care will be taken to safeguard the work from damage. A list of works will be available for gallery visitors when the show opens.

## 5. Sales

Work for this exhibition is not required to be for sale. If it is, please clearly state below how much your work is. Sales will be calculated at the end of the exhibition. g39 will record and hold all monies taken until after the exhibition has closed which will then be distributed by MiR.

## 6. Collection of your work

Artists will be notified of the collection date when their work is delivered. Please note that due to the accumulation of 15 years worth of uncollected work, we've decided that we have to take a stricter stance this year. If you're unable to collect on the dates below, we will keep your work for 2 weeks, and after that it will be donated or disposed of. Please get in touch in advance if you're unable to collect on the designated date.

**Before you deliver your artwork**, please attach the information below to the **back** of your work. (if you can't print the form off, handwritten information is fine). This information is essential for your work to be included, and it would be really helpful if it's done before you get to g39, but we can help you on the drop off day if you're not sure of anything).
